



Undersigned Bálint Glázer, president of the Student Union at the Faculty of Humanities of the University of Pécs (PTE BTK), accordingly to the Constitution of PTE EHÖK, I announce

## The annual election of student representatives for the Faculty of Humanities of the University of Pécs in 2019

as follows:

1. Unless differing regulations are applied, during the election period all students can vote and be elected, who submit a written application within one week of the announcement, to the president of the student union. – (PTE COC attachment no. 43.).69. § (4)
2. The application must contain the followings: - 69. § (5)
  - a. a registration form,
  - b. a valid certificate of student status (can not be older than 15 days),
  - c. the curriculum vitae of the applicant,
  - d. a motivational letter,
  - e. the applicant must validate every page of the application with his/her signature.
3. In case the number of the recieved applications is lower than the dispensable mandates until the deadline, the application period can be extended by one week. - 69. § (6)
4. The Central Election Committee is responsible for conducting the election. The deputy assembly of the student union can temporarily send members to assist the Central Election Committee. – 69. § (7)
5. Student representatives are elected according to their first (major) degree, in case of undivided teacher training, from the major constituency. Each student can only vote for candidates in their constituency. – 89. § (3)
6. All eligible students can only vote for the number of candidates selected from the given constituency. – 89. § (4)
7. After every hundred students, one delegate from each constituency may be delegated to the Assembly. – 89. § (3)
8. If the number of students in a constituency does not reach the number specified in 89. § (4) of the PTE EHÖK Constitution, 1 person from the given constituency shall be delegated to the Assembly. – 89. § (5)
9. Number of constituencies of the BTK HÖK Deputy Assembly and the number of student representatives to be elected by constituencies:
  - a) English constituency - 1 person
  - b) Philosophy and Art Theory constituency - 1 person
  - c) German constituency - 1 person
  - d) Human Development and Cultural Studies constituency - 2 people
  - e) Hungarian Language and Literature Constituency - 1 person
  - f) Educational Studies constituency - 7 people
  - g) Psychology constituency - 5 people
  - h) Romanistics constituency - 1 person
  - i) Slavistics constituency - 1 person
  - j) Social Relations constituency - 3 people
  - k) Society and Media Studies - 1 person
  - l) History Studies constituency - 1 person
10. During the realization of their duties, student representatives shall act in the interest of students of the district in which they were elected – 89. § (6)
11. The mandates shall be allocated per constituency in descending order regarding the number of votes. – 89. § (7)
12. Only those candidates who have submitted a valid application within the deadline for the election may be voted during the election. – 56. § (6)
13. Unless differing regulations are applied, campaign activity can be conducted from the submission of the application forms until the beginning of the campaign silence, determined by Central Election Committee. – 69. § (9)
14. The applications can be submitted personally, or via mail at the following address: 7624 Pécs, Ifjúság útja 6. PTE BTK DiákCentrum
15. Submission period related to the applications:
  - a. personally: **26 March 2019 10:00 – 15 April 2019 12:00**
  - b. via mail (posting deadline): **10 April 2019 14:00**
16. Beginning of the voting period: **16 April 2019**
